Thirty Second Annual Bocce Invitational Tournament Sunday, August 10, 2014

Bocce Rules

- 1. Each team will consist of four (4) players plus an alternate if so desired in both the open as well as the women's tournament. Each team will have 2 players that remain on one side and each player will throw 2 balls.
- 2. If the pallino goes out of bounds, it will be placed on the nail. If the large ball goes out of bounds, it is considered a dead ball. All bocce balls including the pallino must cross the center line to be in play.
- 3. In the event that two opposing balls are equal distance from the pallino, the team that threw LAST will throw until the tie is broken.
- 4. A team must have four (4) players to start a game. A team has 10 minutes, from the time the ref calls for the game to begin, to have an eligible team. Once a player begins a game and is substituted for, he/she may not re-enter the same game.
- 5. Team captains may request a measurement by the referee at any time FOR THE POINT ONLY!
- 6. Referee will handle all games. The Bocce Committee will decide major disputes

On behalf of the Roma Lodge and its members, we would like to invite you to this year's Roma Lodge Bocce Tournament. I hope that you will be able to participate in this exciting event which not only allows everyone to play the wonderful game of bocce, but also presents a festival atmosphere with all the great people who join us.

This year's Roma Lodge Open and Women's Tournament, like last year, will consist of teams of 4 (Men, Women, or a mix) in the open tournament and 4 women in the women's tournament. Each team will assign 2 players to play one end of the bocce court with each player throwing 2 balls. Again, this year's tournament will be Round Robin Style instead of double elimination. This means, basically, that all teams will be playing a minimum of 3 (possibly 4) games instead of 2. All games will be played up to between 9 and 12 points, depending on the number of entries. The quarter finals, semi-finals, and finals will all be played up to 16 points.

This year, we will once again have Roma Lodge's famous food, including pane fritta (fried bread dough), kringle, bombers, tomato salad, corn on the cob, and a Zuddy DeRose dinner special featuring stuffed peppers. Soda and beer will be included from 10:30-3:30. We're expecting a huge response to this year's tournament based on last year's success. A minimum of **\$5,000**. in cash prizes is expected to be awarded between the open and the women's tournament.

For those of you who come from Illinois and the Milwaukee area, we once again look forward to sharing our club with all of you. We look forward to seeing everyone once again! The great thing about our tournament is that we have been fortunate to have good teams come play, but we also have many teams who just love to play bocce...enjoying the food and camaraderie equally as much. Please remember to get your team entry in as early as possible to ensure your team's spot. We are expecting a huge turn-out this year! We hope to make this not only another exciting day as bocce players, but a day that brings Italians together from all over! Hope to see you once again August 18!
